As far as relationships Bubba...I have not done so well. Hopefully that time will come but I am not going to pursue the matter or try to worry about it – I can't. I miss Jayden Dominick so much. But as far as priorities right now, they can't be on them until I go through my classes and I am trying to prepare myself for that. Dominick is going to be ok. He will be 18 years old in 2 and a half years, so after that I'll be ok. Jayden, now that is a different story. I fucked up bro. I do not have a choice now. I have to comply. Jen – I have to let her go. There will be no more. There can't be. I do think about her, but not as much. I have not written or called her. You were right all along, but you did not have to send me a picture with her in it. It stung for a second, just a second. I'm ok. My mom is going to call my probation officer next month and ask all the important questions.



I have had two good talks with my supervisor and a deputy here. First – my supervisor is awesome. She pulled me into her office a few weeks ago and said to me, well, a good heart to heart. She did not have to do that for me. I am in jail. I'm sure she knows why I am in jail but she says that she doesn't. Well she said that I was changing and wanted to talk to me. She said she saw me doing things or acting like other inmates that have come and gone. She said she didn't want to see me come back. I said I can't. It is very easy to lose focus after being here for so long. You adapt and get used to your surroundings. She said to focus and remember why I am here. She said while other people talk

about getting out and drinking and getting high, I talk about going home and that's what she wants to see happen. It truly hit home. Then the next day was like someone was trying to say "Fachini! Stay focused!"

A Deputy – Duran (woman) said "Fachini, why are you here?" I knew she already knew because she mentioned my charge, so I told her why I am not afraid to tell people what I am here for. I am ashamed and embarrassed. We talked for about 45 minutes, mostly me telling her what happened and how it happened. I told her that I do care what people think! I don't want to be looked at like a child molester. She seemed very warm & cool. She had always been cool to me before. Well today I saw her again and spoke to her for a few and told her that I hope she doesn't look at me any different than before. She said she felt bad for me and that things will be ok, just to stay focused and not fuck up. It meant a lot coming from a deputy. They did not make me come here I did this to myself. It's kind of crazy when I walk through the facility for work. All the Deputies say hi and are really cool to me. I have never had one problem. They always joke with me and ask when I go home.





So I am spending more time reading and working out. I am still the Pod Rep and feel like people respect me (my nickname is the 'Podfather'). I help when I can with haircuts, phone calls, food, talks to others to make them see the positive. Kandy has been good about writing. She has been awesome. Man...your pops. Please keep me updates. I will keep him in my prayers and thoughts. Well, another girl huh? Right on! As for getting here...you have done enough. I will see you soon.
